Reference (1) is regarding the circular from UGC for guidelines of examinationa and acedemic calender, keeping in vew the prevailing situation due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Reference(2) is regarding the circular of University regarding merit based progresion in the intermediate semester for all the degree as well as diploma courses.

Reference (3) is regarding the circular of University regarding offline examination of PG courses

Reference (4) is regarding start of offline class-room teaching

Reference (5 and 6) is regarding re-opening of colleges

With referece to the above UGC circular and with the view of significant reduction COVID-19 cases, UGC revise the guidelines on Examination and Academic Calender.

The provision as contained in the circular issued earlier as mentioned above (Ref 2 and 3) shall apply for the current academic session 2020-21. Further, the offline examination of PG courses be compulsorily conducted in offline (pen and paper) mode (Ref 3) by no later than 31st August 2021 following the prescribed protocol/ guidelines related to COVID-19 pandemic. For intermidiate semester/year courses, assessment shall be based on internal evaluation and previous semester as suggested in Ref 2.
