## Orientation program for UPSC CSE (IAS)

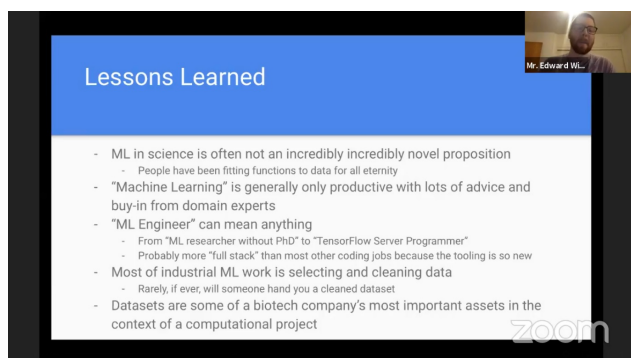

for campus interview. Four students in the final year computer department were selected by the company.



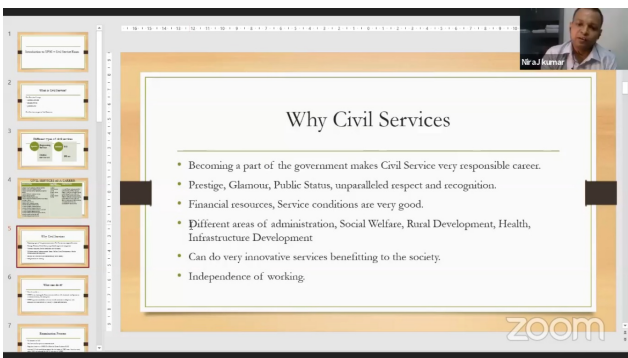

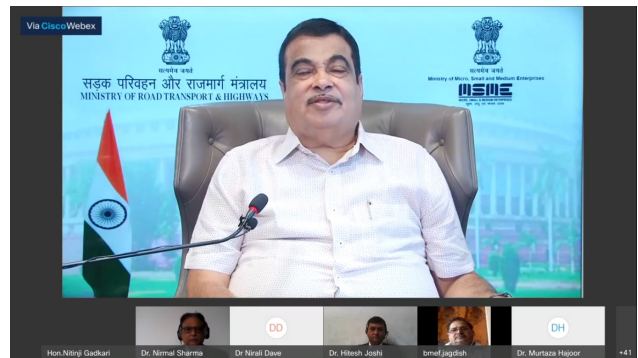

### Felicitation of Corona Warriors of Bhagwan Mahavir University

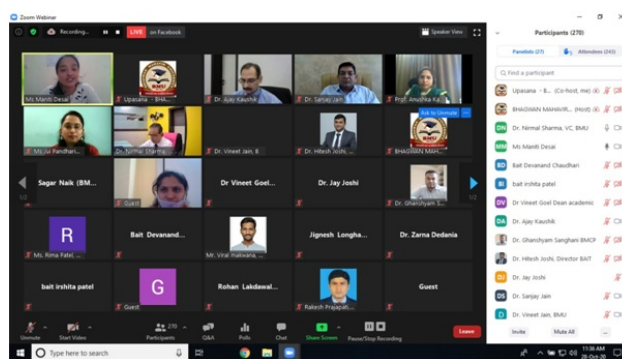

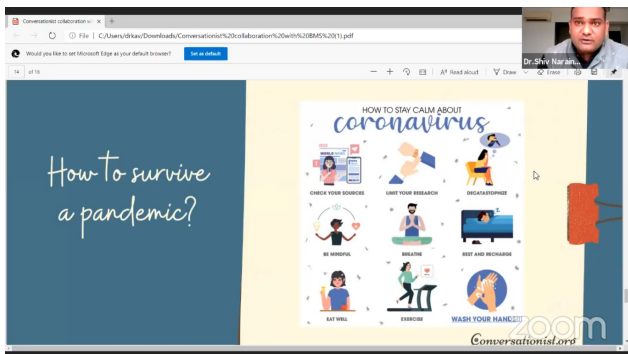

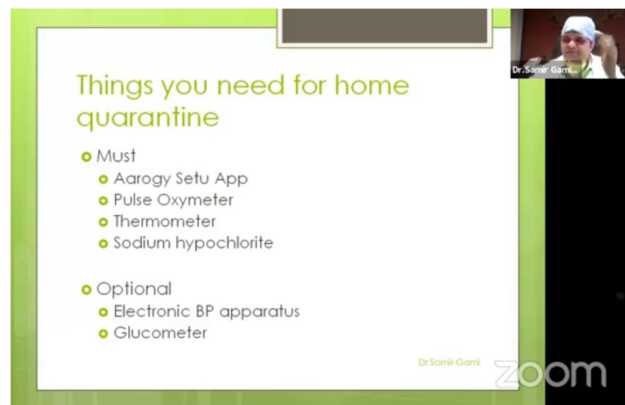

## One Week For Nation (Day 4) : National E-Conference on “Green Energy & Environmental Technology- 2020”

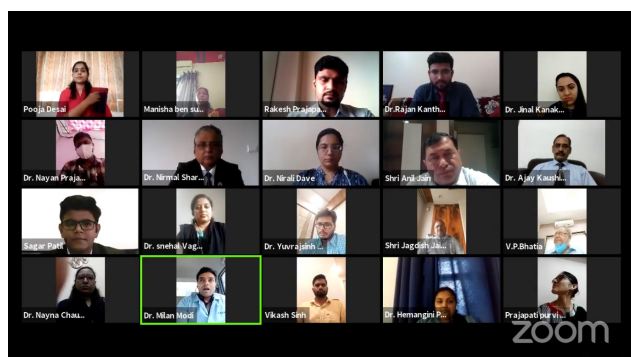

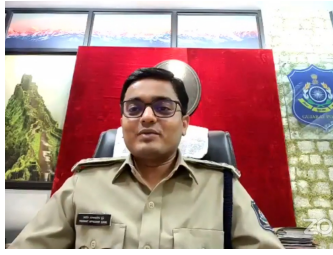

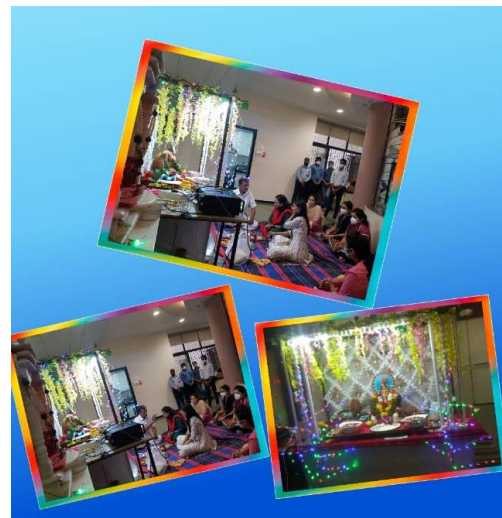
Glimpse of virtual marathon “Run For Warriors” as a part of One week for nation

### Celebration of Ganesh Utsav in Bhagwan Mahavir University

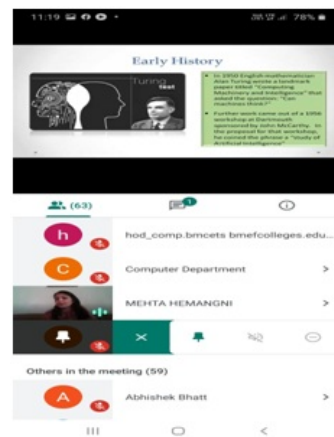

### Age structure, growth rate and exploitation pattern of *Cirrhinus mrigala* (Ham. 1822) in Vallabhsagar reservoir, Gujarat, India

Mrigal, *Cirrhinus mrigala* (Ham. 1822), one of the Indian major carps widely distributed in Indian inland waters, has considerable aquaculture potential. Knowledge on factors such as age, growth and exploitation pattern is important in fisheries management. Here, we investigated the age structure, growth increment and exploitation pattern of mrigal in Vallabhsagar reservoir, Gujarat (India). Age composition of the studied fish was 1+ to 9+ age groups with mean total lengths 40.78, 50.99, 59.82, 66.32, 70.72, 75.56, 77.80, 80.22 and 82.50 cm. The corresponding growth rate in terms of length were 40.78, 10.21, 8.83, 6.50, 4.40, 3.84, 3.24, 2.42 and 2.28 cm observed for these age groups. The growth increment was maximum at the initial age group whereas it was moderate to low in the subsequent years of the age. The exploitation patterns of fish were 0.61 for 1+, 2.02 for 2+, 2.17 for 3+, 2.12 for 4+, 2.96 for 5+, 0.16 for 6+, 4.43 for 7+, 2.46 for 8+ and 0.74% for 9+ age classes. Results depict that exploitation pattern of fish was high at early age fish stock than the higher age classes. The exploitation pattern for 1+ to 3+ age classes was 58.13% and 41.87% contributed by 4+ to 9+ age classes. Higher catch rate of younger fishes is not a good sign for natural stocking of fish i.e. mrigal in the Vallabhsagar reservoir.

The age of fish refers to the numerical expression of the time duration that fish has lived whereas growth of animals is considered change in body size between two points or increase in volume mass<sup>1,2</sup>.

The age and growth of different fish species are usually analyzed by means of hard parts<sup>3</sup> and such studies for Indian major carps were conducted by Johal & Tandon<sup>4</sup> from three reservoirs of north India. Similar attempts were made from Jaisamand Lake, Rajasthan, from Silabath reservoir, Alwar (Rajasthan)<sup>5</sup> and from other water bodies of southern Rajasthan<sup>6</sup>. Such studies are also reported from Hanik wetland, India<sup>7</sup>, Rana Pratap Sagar, Rajasthan<sup>8</sup> and from reservoirs of Chattisgarh<sup>9</sup> and also from culture based reservoir<sup>10</sup> and from Vallabhsagar reservoir, Gujarat<sup>11</sup>. The ratio of different age classes in population at a given time representing the exploitation pattern of population<sup>12</sup>. The exploitation pattern of *Tetraodon lineatus* from foothills of river Ganga<sup>13</sup> and *Aorichthys senegalensis* from Yamuna and Ganga has been reported elsewhere<sup>14</sup>. Studies on the exploitation pattern of *Cirrhinus mrigala* are also not uncommon<sup>15,16</sup>.

Determination of age, growth and exploitation pattern of fishes are useful to solve the basic life history problems and also essential for formulating future policies and management of the fishery. Considering these important biological aspects, we investigated the exploitation pattern of *Cirrhinus mrigala* in Vallabhsagar reservoir in Tapi, Surat (Gujarat).

## LIMNOLOGICAL STUDY IN VALLABHSAGAR RESERVOIR, GUJARAT (INDIA)

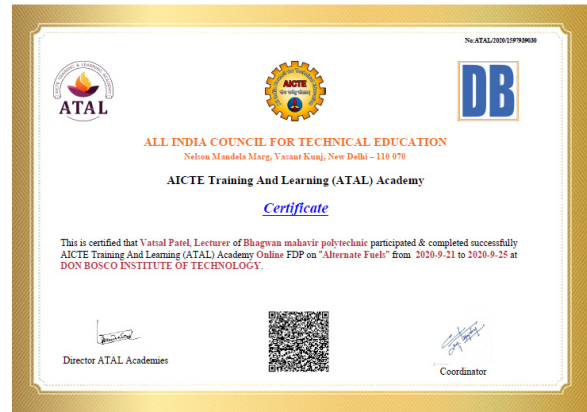
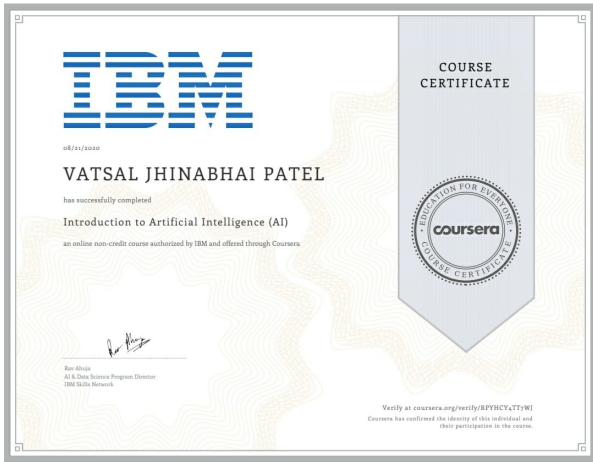

### Abstract

In this paper important physicochemical properties like temperature, turbidity, total solids, total dissolved solids, dissolved oxygen, hardness, nitrate-N, nitrite-N, ammonia, phosphate, chlorophyll-a and plankton were analysed during the month of June 2014 to May 2015 in Vallabhsagar reservoir of Gujarat. The overall average values of various parameters such as temperature (25.7°C), turbidity (15.8 NTU), Total solids (208.2 mg/l), Total dissolved solids (132 mg/l), dissolved oxygen (7.94 mg/l), hardness (61.1 mg/l), nitrate-N (1.12 mg/l), nitrite-N (0.08 mg/l), ammonia (0.17 mg/l), phosphate (0.90 mg/l), Chlorophyll-a (0.07 mg/l) and plankton (3230 no/l) were favourable. The observed values of the present study were within the optimum limits of physicochemical parameters for fish farming or aquaculture. On the basis of results it can be concluded that aquatic environment of Vallabhsagar is congenial and conducive for fish farming activities.

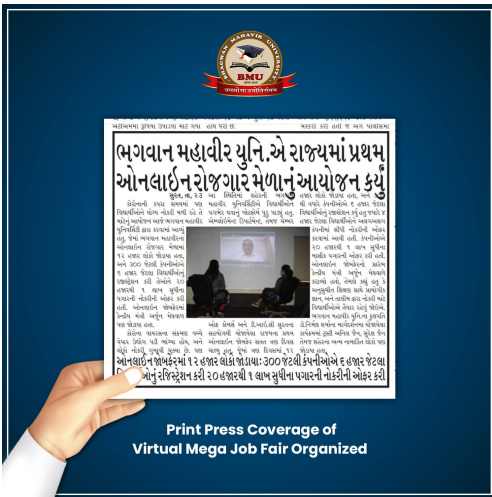
