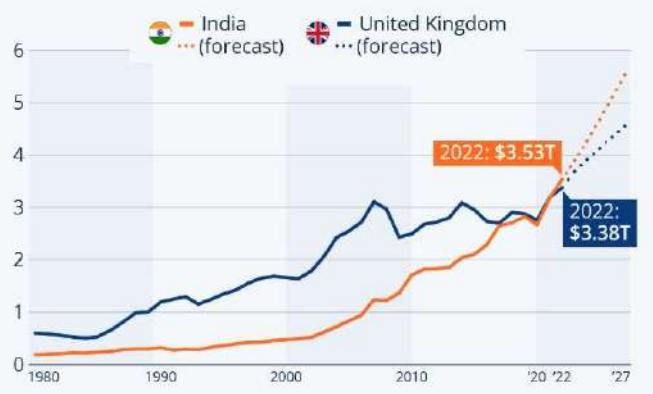

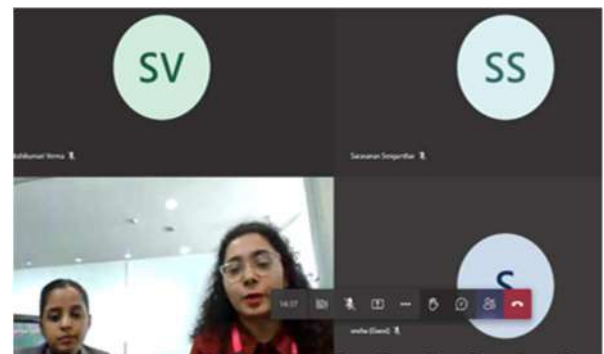
### **TEACHERS DAY PROGRAMME by BMCN**

### **GANESHOTSAV Celebration by SBCE**

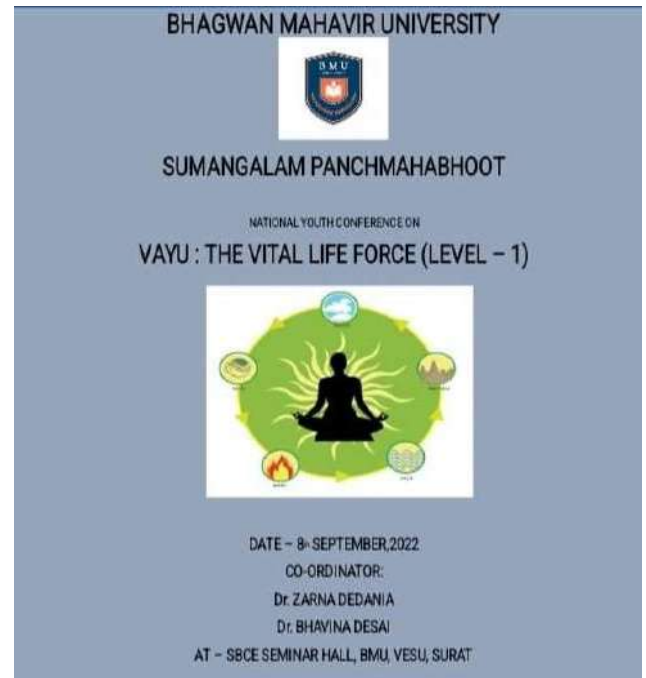
