



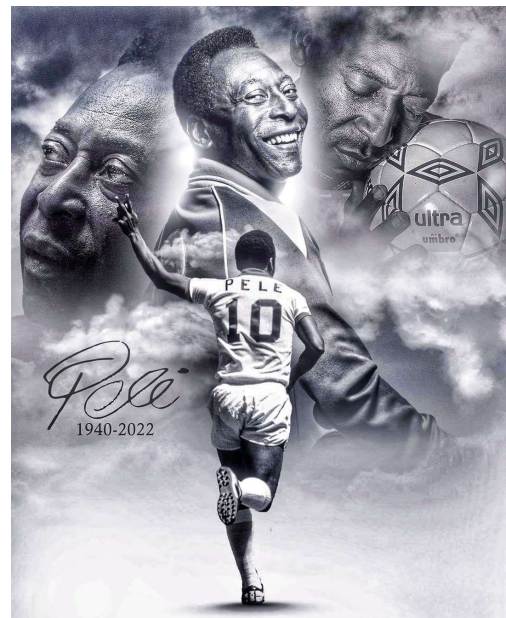

lecture on Cyber Security Awareness. Total 175 students and 10 faculties attended the seminar.

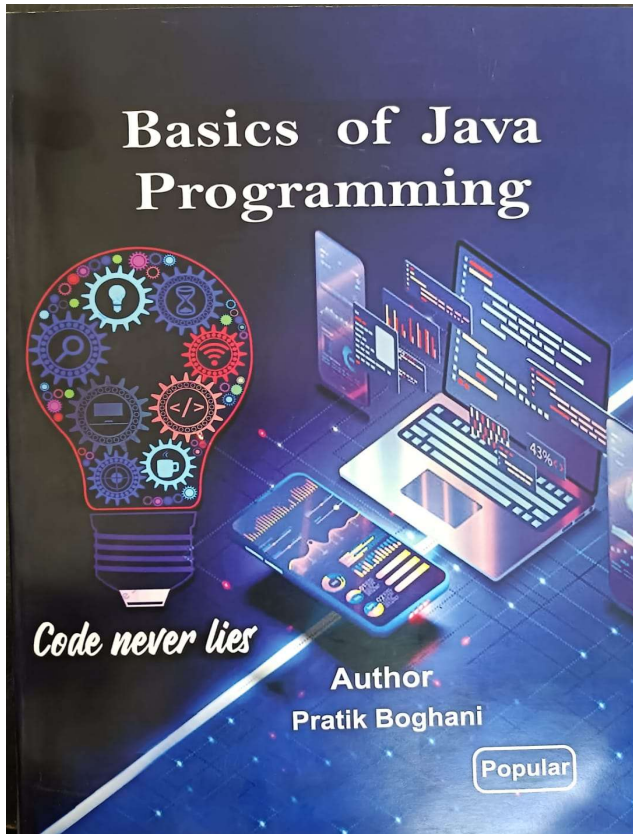


PAPER PRESENTED by BMCCA

team from Health Zone. It had a total of 25 faculties including both teaching and non-teaching staff.



NUKKAD NATAK by BMCN

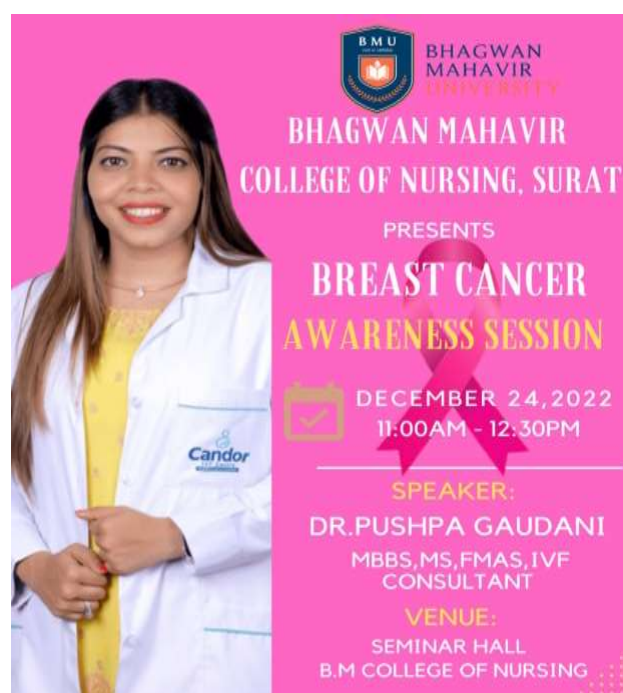

NAVRATRI CELEBRATION by SBCE

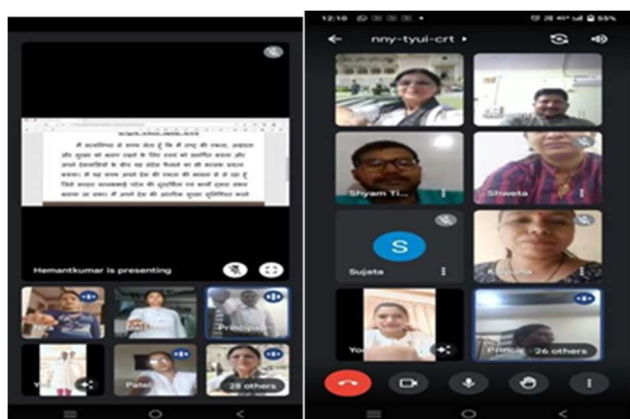


Shikshan Bharti College of education celebrated Diwali on 3rd October-2022. The program was

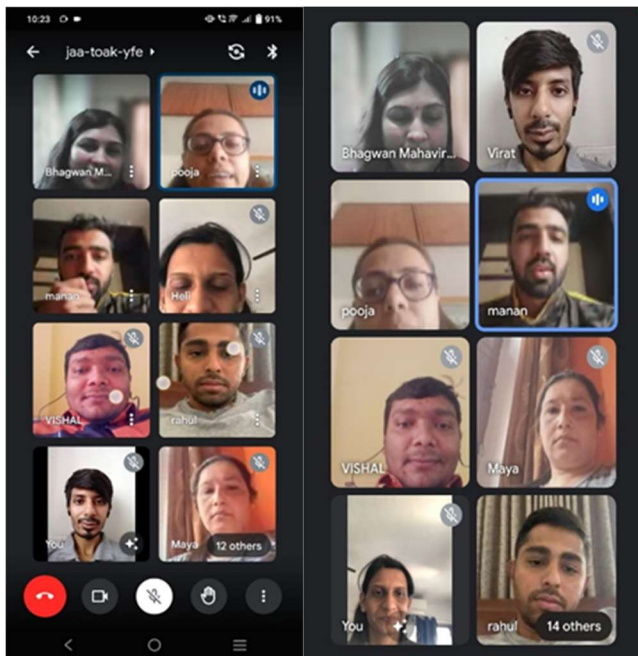

AWARENESS SEMINAR by BMCM

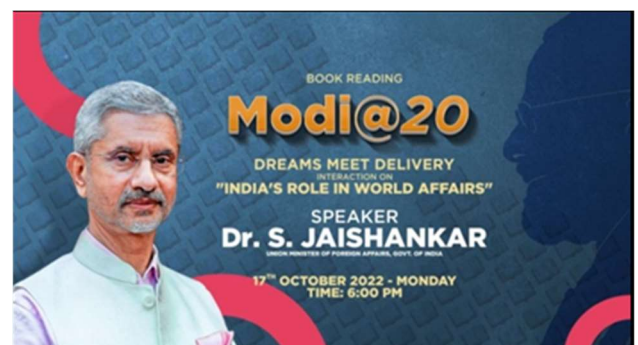
