










#### **Anemia Screening Programme by BMCN**


**Awareness Towards** E-Waste **Disposal** Management & Its Adaptive Reuses by BMCA.

#### **Expert Lecture on Photography by BMCA**




Students learned about the salient features of Town Planning Schemes and explore what local/ state governments are doing to tackle the issues while
